



Dr. Gagnon's current fee for service is \$160.00 per hour.

Initial in-person consultation: A complete neuropsychological assessment is a very thought process and might not always be warranted. An initial in-person consultation is suggested. This initial consultation is a 90-120 minute appointment during which Dr. Gagnon will conduct a full interview and basic cognitive screening, as necessary. Based on this initial assessment, a full neuropsychological assessment will be recommended or not. You may also receive suggestions and recommendations or a brief educational session, depending on the initial findings and clinical impressions.

Full Neuropsychological Evaluation: A typical neuropsychological evaluation ranges from 7-8 hours to 12-14 hours total. This includes time to review records, interview the patient and his or her family, conduct the evaluation, score the results, prepare a final report summarizing the findings and go over these findings with the patient/client and/or referral source. A flat fee can be discussed. However, unless other agreements are made, Dr. Gagnon charges for services by the hour.

Legal Consultations: Legal consultations include deposition time, court appearances and consultations with the attorney. The above 3 specific services are billed at the cost of \$400 per hour. Deposition time is billed at a minimum of 2 hours. Court appearances are billed at a minimum of 4 hours. Payment in advance is required for Legal Consultation.

Cancellations: Please notify me as soon as possible if you must cancel a scheduled appointment by calling my confidential voice mail at 514-618-0543. With the exception of a crisis, a 2-day notice is required for any cancellation. A 200\$ fee is required for last-minute cancellations (less than 48 hours before the appointment).

Payments: Payment can be made by check or cash. Payment is due at the end of the consultation or at the end of the report writing, except for email transfer, where the payment is due at the beginning of the session. If a check is returned NSF, the client is responsible for any bank charges that apply. Upon receipt of payment a receipt is provided. This receipt can be submitted to your insurance company for reimbursement in line with your own contract with your insurance company – ask your insurance company for details. Note that if you do not have coverage, the costs of therapy can still be claimed on your income tax as a medical expense – ask your accountant for details.
